1. Call to Order - Meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm by Mayor Scott.
2. Approval of the Agenda with additions of ATV bylaw discussion - Moved by Councillor Tanya Campbell and seconded by Councillor Kelly Scott.

5. Public Presentation/Petitions/Delegations -

6. Reports -

- b) CAO Report was given by Connie - there was no motions to approve

8. New Grant from the Province was discussed. All Municipalities will be receiving a \$15,000.00 grant.

9. A little discussion was had about the possibility of looking for funding to have Artists to commissioned pieces throughout the Village... also the possibility of

letting local artists have the Hall for an Art Exhibit/Show. It was agreed to let Connie research all of this further

10. Gas Tax Account - It was discussed that the Banking Account that the Gas Tax is sitting in is charging the Municipality a monthly fee. Connie is going to find out if we can get this switched to an Account that's building interest with no monthly fees.


11. Parking lot by the Rink - Connie is going to price out different options for fixing the parking lot for Rink and report back at the June Meeting.


